Shea has not been in contact with his old friends since being incarcerated. The reason for severing old relationships is as Shea puts it, "no good will come to me if I reacquaint myself with them because those friends were not good influences when I was free and they will not be good influences once I am free again."

If Shea is granted his request for conditional pardon, his sister and brother-in-law will take Shea into their home. They will also help Shea reintegrate into society by helping him gain employment through members of their Church and/or various friends throughout their community in Chesapeake, VA. Shea has been investing \$25 to \$50/month in a mutual fund since June 2020. This money is his and will be there for him upon his release, which he has invested in both short and long-term holding.

Certain goals will be set for Shea to achieve, which will assist in his reintegration into society and support him so that he will be able to live on his own once he is financially stable. His support system will leave no room for missteps, even more so once he is released. He will be living in a drug-free home with his loved ones, all the while attending personal and professional growth meetings and church services since activities are major steps that will help keep Shea focused and clean. Shea will attend classes to further his understanding of computer software so that he will be a desired and sought-after contributor for a job that he is interested in doing.

Shea hopes to secure work in an IT field, but will seek out any employment he can find, which will not be hard for him to do with his sister and brother-in-law's large network of friends and close associates. There are plenty of individuals who want to see Shea succeed and will take steps to see it become a reality.
