

Shea told her it was no joke and that he was there only for the money and that nobody was going to get hurt as long as she did as instructed, all the while pointing the BB gun at her. A [REDACTED] asked about Z [REDACTED], imploring for information on his safety at which point Shea called for J [REDACTED] and when he came to Shea's call, Z [REDACTED] was not with him. Shea told J [REDACTED] to go back and get the kid. At this point A [REDACTED] said she didn't feel well and Shea told her to sit down next to the office door and things would be over shortly. She said she had meds in her purse and as Shea was helping A [REDACTED] sit down, J [REDACTED] showed up with Z [REDACTED] at which point Shea instructed him to sit next to A [REDACTED]. Shea then handed J [REDACTED] the BB gun and told him to watch both employees and the parking lot as he went into the office to collect the money. After he got everything out of the safe, Shea then removed the surveillance VHS tapes from the recorder and came out of the office. He retrieved the BB gun from J [REDACTED] and told both A [REDACTED] and Z [REDACTED] that they would now be placed into the walk-in cooler.

At this point, A [REDACTED] said she was having pain in her chest. Shea helped her up and with Z [REDACTED]'s help, led her to the walk-in. Once inside the walk-in, Shea asked if she was okay which she replied, "No," her chest hurt and that she had meds in her purse. Shea asked where it was to which she said it was in the office. Shea went to retrieve the purse with the meds and when he came back with the purse, he checked it to make sure no phone was in it before he handed it to A [REDACTED]. Before she could get it though, J [REDACTED] grabbed it and pulled A [REDACTED]'s wallet out of the purse and removed her license then he made some type of threat to A [REDACTED] as he tossed her the purse. Shea then told J [REDACTED] to go get a water for her so that she could take her meds. After she was given the water, Shea and J [REDACTED] closed the walk-in and Shea placed the padlock on the door but purposely upside down and unlocked thinking it would slip off after some shaking from either Z [REDACTED] and/or A [REDACTED]'s attempts to get out.

At this point both Shea and J [REDACTED] left Burger King and ran back to where they parked the car. After returning to Shea's place, they divided the money, J [REDACTED] left, and Shea went to sleep.

Throughout the next day, Shea tried to contact J [REDACTED] with no results. Shea spent the day trying to find a ride to buy marijuana, but did not find any. He went to a Toys-R-Us down the street from where he lived and bought some presents for his niece and nephew while at the same time buying a PlayStation 2 and a couple of games for himself. Around 5-7pm, Shea was arrested for the robbery and later found out that J [REDACTED] had been arrested earlier in the morning and led the police to Shea.
