Williamsburg	Robbery (2 counts)	2 Life sentences; all suspended except for 10 years
Williamsburg	Abduction (2 counts)	2 Life sentences; all suspended except for 10 years
Williamsburg	Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony (4 counts)	3 years on the first count, 5 years on the second count, 5 years on the third count, and 5 years on the fourth count for a total of 18 years to run consecutively with each other and the 20 years from the original felonies. <i>These convictions were given for a BB gun used in the robbery, which does not lessen the seriousness of the crimes. The judge could have ran this time concurrently if he knew it was in his power to do so. <u>Brown v. Commonwealth 284 Va. 538, 733 S.E. 2d 638(2012)</u>, found that judges have been misinterpreting the law and ruled that judges have the authority to run this time concurrently with other counts of the same conviction. Therefore, Shea's 18 years for the Use of a Firearm in the Commission of a Felony could of been 5 years if the judge knew it was in his power to do so.</i>
Yorktown	Embezzlement	Reimposed sentence of 20 years. <i>The total amount taken was \$246.76 and yet the judge of this case exceeded the sentence guidelines which was 2-3 years and gave Shea 20 years instead.</i>
